

Square Box - *Hako*

What do you need

1 sheet of Bonjardim origami paper for the lid.

1 sheet of Bonjardim origami slightly smaller for the box base.

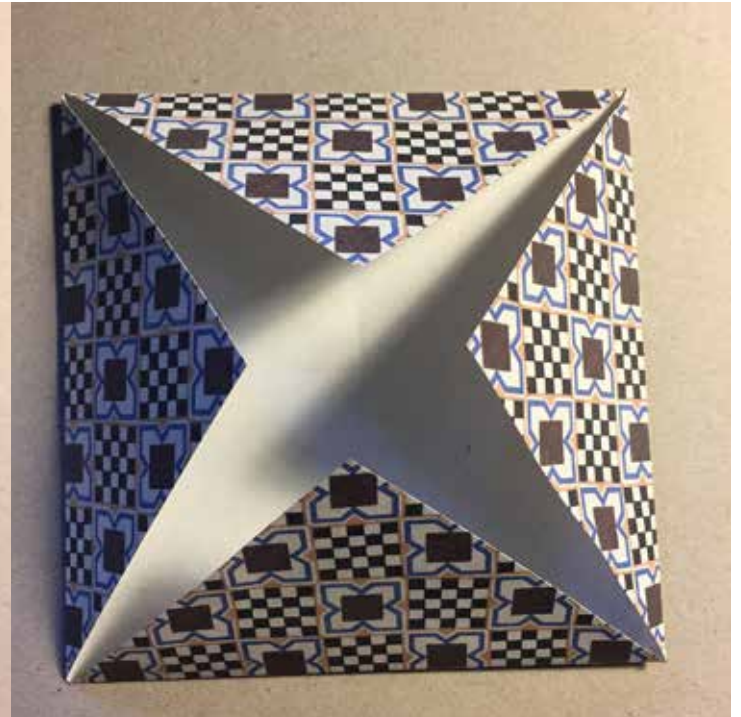
Check the table for different sized boxes.

Paper size for lid	15cm x 15cm	20cm x 20cm	25cm x 25cm	30cm x 30cm
Lid size	5.5cm x 5.5cm x 2.5cm	7.5cm x 7.5cm x 3.5cm	8.5cm x 8.5cm x 4.5cm	10.5cm x 10.5cm x 5.5cm
Paper size for box	14cm x 14cm	19cm x 19cm	24cm x 24cm	28.5cm x 28.5cm
Box size	5cm x 5cm x 2.4cm	6.5cm x 6.5cm x 3.4cm	8cm x 8cm x 4.4cm	10cm x 10cm x 5.4cm

How to make a square box

1. Gather 2 sheets of origami paper, one slightly bigger than the other.

2. Start of with the zabuton shape, described in a separate tutorial.



3. Fold the top and bottom edges towards the centre.



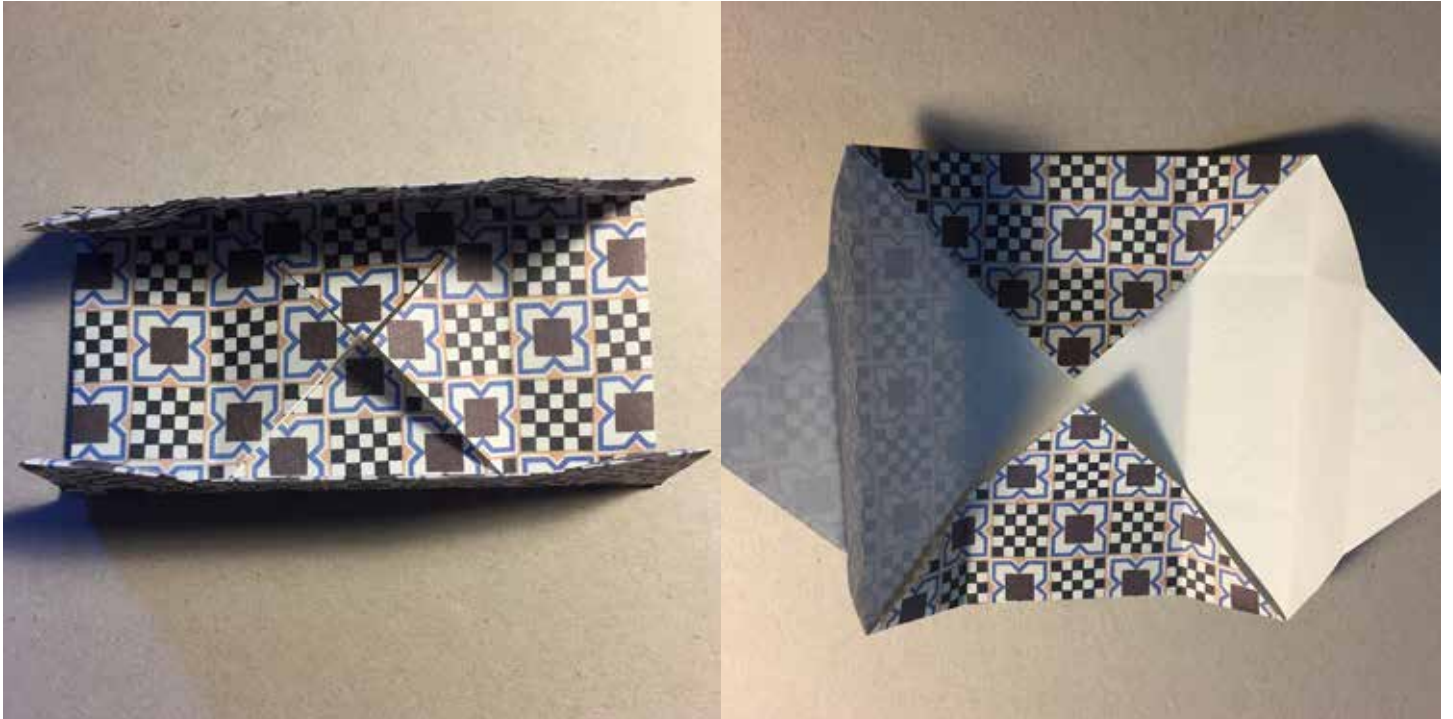
4. Unfold back to the Zabuton and rotate 90°.



5. Fold the top and bottom edges towards the centre, making a rectangle.

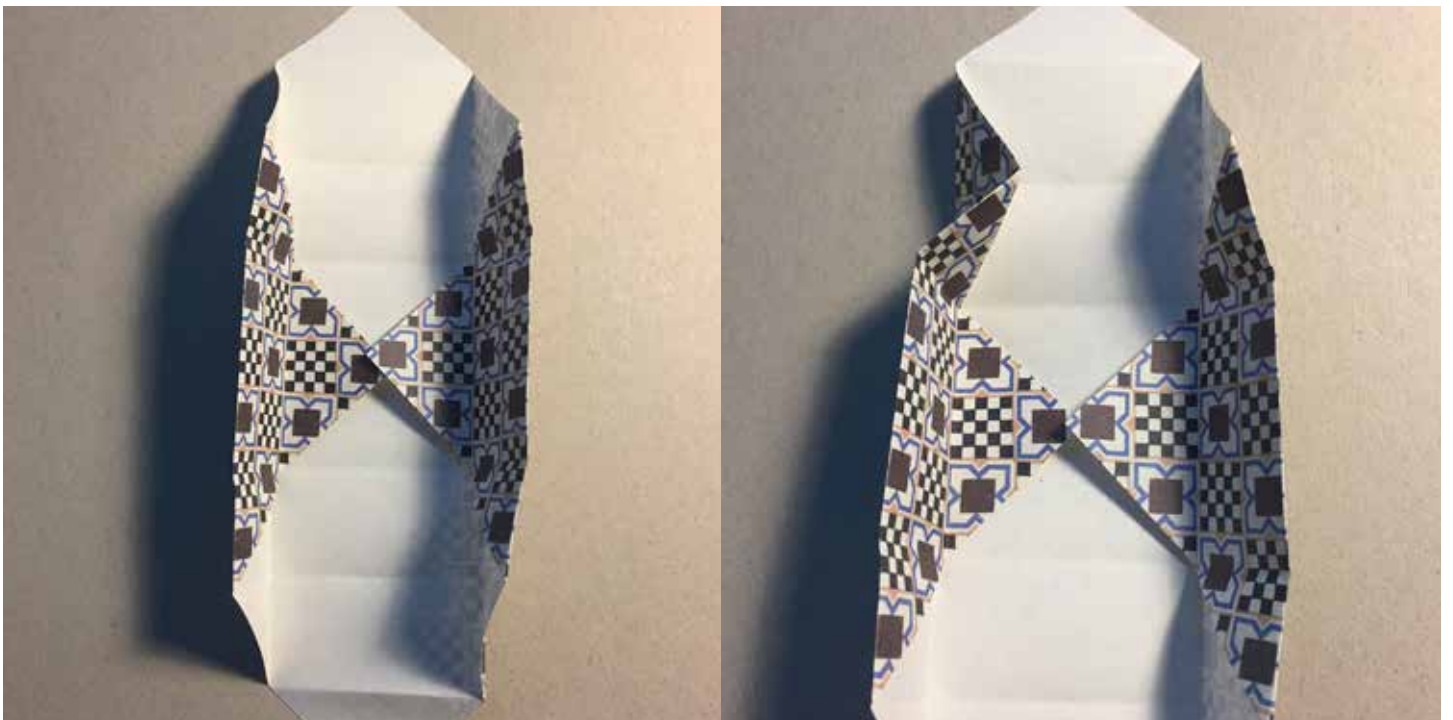


6. Unfold the left and the right sides.

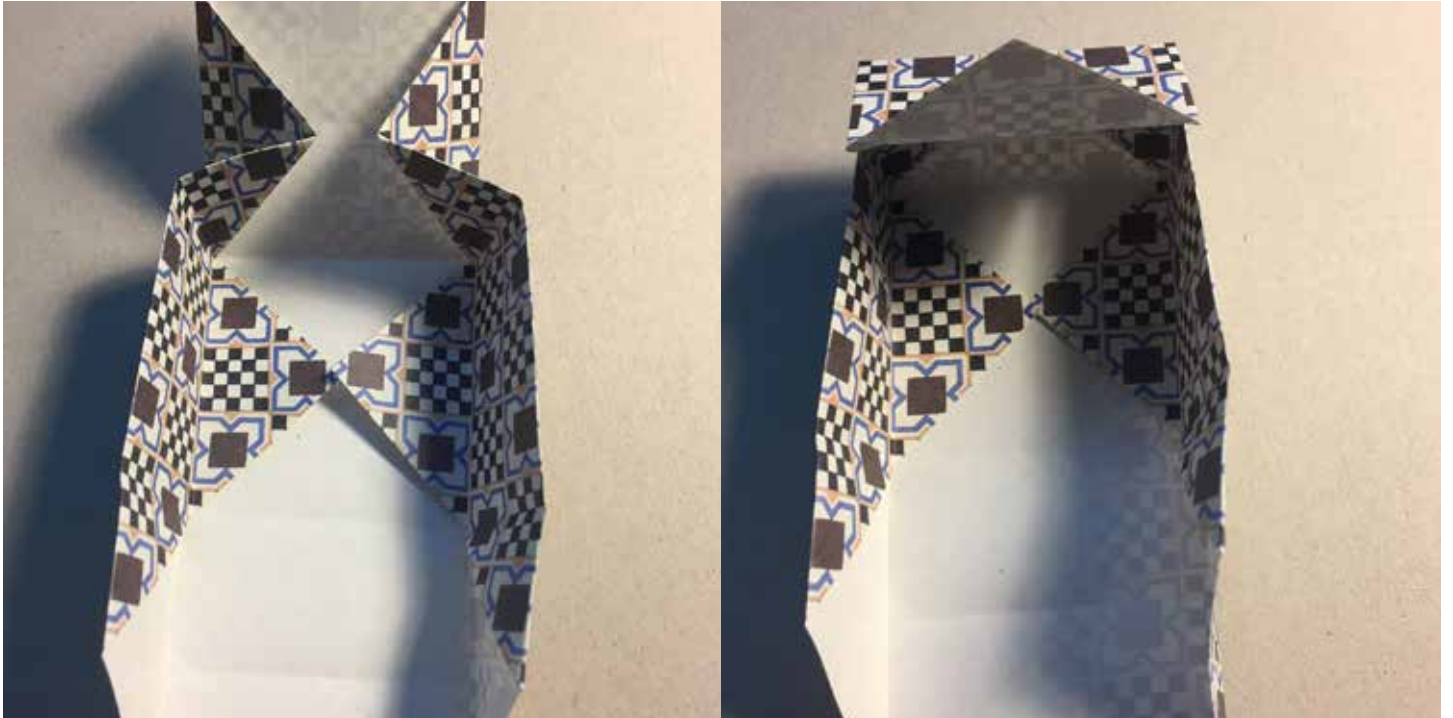


7. Rotate 90° and lift the sides up.

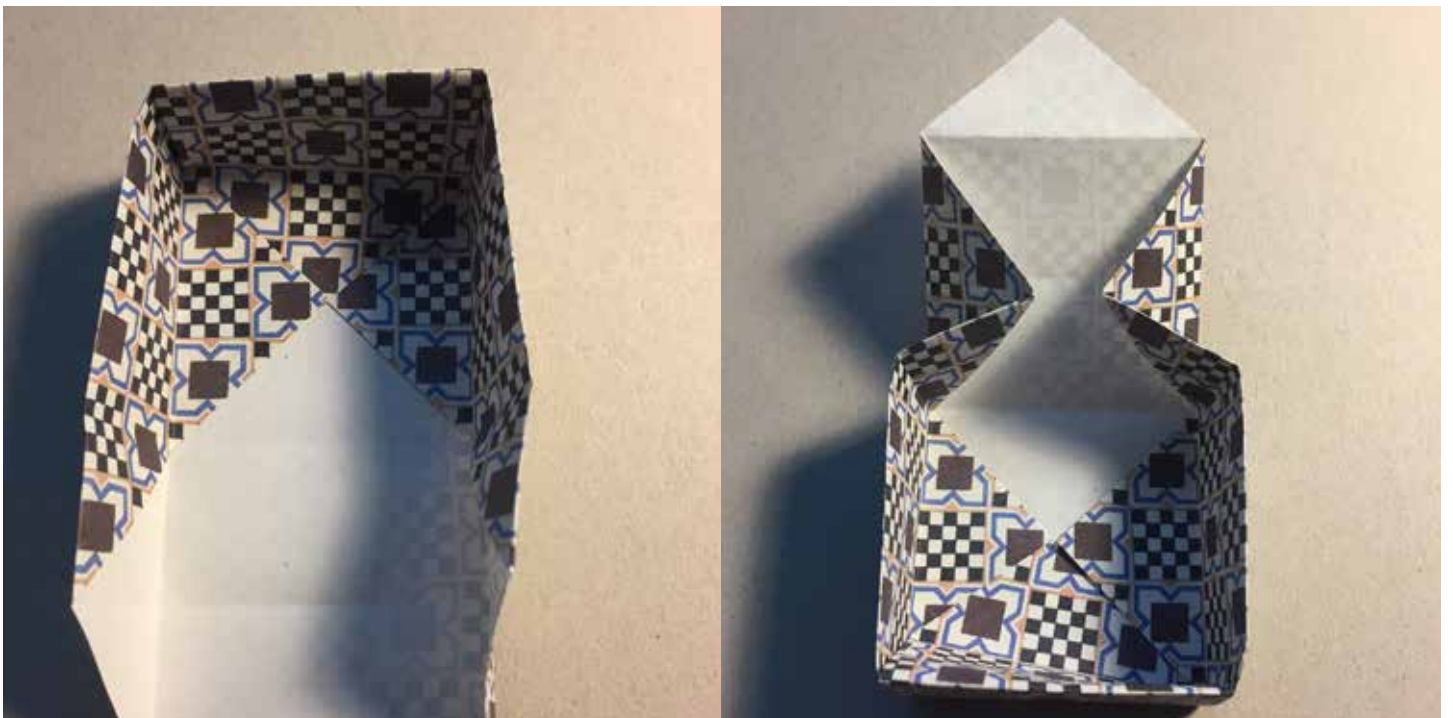
8. Make the reverse folds at each corner of the box.



9. Fold the flap down to make the side of the box covering the side wall and the bottom of the box.



10. Repeat the previous steps to make the other side of the box.



11. Repeat the procedure in order to make the base of the box.
